<u>Psalms Overview</u> – religious poetry for prayer, worship, and instruction

Acrostic – alphabetic poem (stanzas start with each letter in succession) Bicola – two-line verse

Synonymous parallelism – two lines say almost the same thing Antithetical parallelism – two lines say the opposite Synthetic parallelism – Any other relationship between the two lines

Categories

Laments – suffering and crying to God for help (individual or communal) (44, 60) Thanksgiving– hymns praising God for his general goodness and greatness (150) Wisdom–glory to God's law/instruction, a sound guide for living life (1, 19, 119) Royal – glorify the king or praise God for putting the king in place (2, 45, 89, 110) Zion – glorify Zion (aka Jerusalem) (46-48, 84, 132) Messianic – prophecies of Jesus (22) Imprecatory – call down curses on enemies (137)

Covenants Overview - family bond sealed with an oath (break, reject/disobey God)

Adamic - Adam and Eve, creatures from the ground, God wanted children & made covenant with them. *Covenant of creation.* Broken (Gen 3).

Noahic - Flood ended hatred/evil, saved Noah & his family with pairs of animals in the ark. After flood, God made a covenant with Noah adopting him as a son. *Covenant of water.* Broken (Gen 9).

Abrahamic - God decided to work with one man & his family through which to bring all human beings back into the family of God. *Covenant of cutting.* Broken (Gen 27–37).

- 1. Covenant-Between-the-Pieces (Gen 15)
- 2. Covenant of Circumcision (Gen 17)
- 3. Covenant of Sacrifice of Isaac (Gen 22)

Mosaic - God sent Moses, lead from Egypt to Mt. Sinai to give Ten Commandments. *Covenant of law.* Broken (Ex 32 & Deut 1-2), law extended as penance (Deut 4–28).

Davidic – David, man after God's own heart (1 Sam 13:14) – open to the Spirit (perm. gift 1 Sam 16:13), cont. w/ Solomon, broken by both (2 Sam 11 & 1 Kgs 11).

New (Eucharistic) – Prophets foretold, Jesus brought thru last supper/passion/death/ resurrection. <u>Covenant Hierarchy</u>: King & Queen, Steward & Officers (Apostles & Bishops).
