5 *Psalms in this book you must know* -Psalm 73 (Consoling), 81 (God's rebuke for sin), 84 (How lovely is your dwelling place), 88 (Darkness) & 89 (Hesed-Mercy)

Ps 78:67 RSV2CE Joseph Progenitor of the Tribe of Ephraim: He rejected the tent of Joseph, he did not choose the tribe of Ephraim.

Ps 84 RSV2CE The Joy of Worship in the Temple: How lovely is your dwelling place, O Lord of hosts! My soul longs, yes, faints for the courts of the Lord; my heart and my flesh sing for joy to the living God. Even the sparrow find a home, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young, at your altars, O Lord of hosts, my King and my God. Blessed are those who dwell in your house, ever singing your praise! Blessed are the men whose strength is in you, in whose heart are the highways to Zion. As they go through the valley of Baca they make it a place of springs; the early rain also covers it with pools. They go from strength to strength; the God of gods will be seen in Zion.
